Registration for fall classes begins June 5, 2023 for member families, and June 8, 2023 for the general public. General registration ends on July 15th, 2023 for classes beginning in August, and on July 31st, 2023 for classes beginning in September.

A class that is not full can continue to take registrations past those dates with the instructor's approval, but are subject to a late-add fee of \$50 per student per class for members, and \$75 for non-members.

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## ***Payments, Cancellations, and Refunds***

A deposit is required at the time of registration. Deposits are fully refundable for cancellations made within 14 days of registration. You must contact our office by phone or email to request a cancellation. No refunds are given on deposits after 14 days.

We reserve the right to cancel any class due to staff changes or low enrollment. If The Triangle Homeschool Resource Center cancels a class, all monies paid for that class will be fully refunded. Similarly, if a class changes day, time, staff, or content, all those registered will be contacted to be made aware of changes and given 14 days from notice to request a full refund.

Class tuition payments are charged on the first of the month across 4 months. If a student withdraws from a class after classes begin, payments will be stopped, but no monies already paid are refunded.

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## ***Please note that students under 10 cannot be dropped off at our facility for classes and events.***
